

HUBUNGAN PENGETAHUAN DENGAN SIKAP BIDAN DALAM PELAKSANAAN ANC SESUAI STANDAR 12T DI WILAYAH KERJA PUSKESMAS SUKARAME KABUPATEN TASIKMALAYA .

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ABSTRAK

Pelayanan antenatal sesuai standar meliputi anamnesis, pemeriksaan fisik (umum dan kebidanan), pemeriksaan laboratorium rutin dan khusus, serta intervensi umum dan khusus (sesuai resiko yang ditemukan dalam pemeriksaan). Tujuan penelitian adalah untuk mengetahui hubungan antara pengetahuan dengan sikap bidan dalam pelaksanaan ANC sesuai standar 12T di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Sukarame Kabupaten Tasikmalaya tahun 2026. Jenis penelitian ini adalah observasional analitik dengan menganalisis kuesioner dan *cross sectional* untuk mengetahui besarnya hubungan antara pengetahuan dan sikap bidan terhadap pelayanan ANC dengan standar 10T. Populasi penelitian adalah seluruh Bidan di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Sukarame Kabupaten Tasikmalaya sebanyak 30 responden. Data yang diperoleh dari hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa mayoritas responden mempunyai tingkat pengetahuan tentang ANC dengan standar 12T baik. Dan sangat positif terhadap pelaksanaan ANC sesuai standar 12T. Dari 27 soal pengetahuan yang di ajukan peneliti, terdapat 20 (66,7%) berpengetahuan baik tentang ANC sesuai standar 12T. Kemudian dari total 28 item kuisisioner tentang sikap, terdapat 27 orang (90%) mempunyai sikap positif terhadap pelaksanaan ANC dengan standar 12T dan 23 orang bidan (76,6%) sudah melaksanakan ANC sesuai dengan standar 12T. Dari pengolahan data diperoleh kesimpulan bahwa terdapat hubungan antara pengetahuan dan sikap bidan terhadap pelayanan ANC dengan standar 12T. dimana nilai p value 0,000, nilai ini lebih kecil dari nilai $\alpha = 0,005$.

THE CORRELATION BETWEEN MIDWIVES' KNOWLEDGE AND ATTITUDES TOWARD THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ANTENATAL CARE (ANC) ACCORDING TO THE 12T

**STANDARD IN THE WORK AREA OF SUKARAME PUBLIC HEALTH CENTER,
TASIKMALAYA REGENCY**

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ABSTRACT

Standardized antenatal care includes anamnesis, physical examination (general and obstetrical), routine and special laboratory examinations, as well as general and specific interventions (based on risks detected during examination). This study aims to determine the correlation between midwives' knowledge and attitudes toward the implementation of ANC according to the 12T standard in the work area of Sukarame Public Health Center, Tasikmalaya Regency in 2026. This research employed an analytical observational method by analyzing questionnaires and using a cross-sectional approach to determine the correlation between midwives' knowledge and attitudes toward ANC services under the 10T standard. The research population consisted of all 30 midwives in the work area of Sukarame Public Health Center, Tasikmalaya Regency as respondents. The data obtained from this study indicated that the majority of respondents possessed a good level of knowledge regarding ANC under the 12T standard. Furthermore, they showed highly positive attitudes toward the implementation of ANC according to the 12T standard. Out of 27 knowledge questions presented by the researcher, 20 respondents (66.7%) demonstrated good knowledge of ANC according to the 12T standard. Out of a total of 28 attitude questionnaire items, 27 respondents (90%) had positive attitudes toward the implementation of ANC with the 12T standard, and 23 midwives (76.6%) had implemented ANC according to the 12T standard. Based on data processing, it can be concluded that there is a significant correlation between midwives' knowledge and attitudes toward ANC services under the 12T standard, where the p -value is 0.000, which is smaller than the significance level of $\alpha = 0.005$.
