A Systematic Review: Partograph Adherence Trends in Various Health Care

INTRODUCTION

A partograph is a tool used to monitor the progress of labor and identify potential complications. The proper use of a partograph can help promote safe and planned labor. However, research shows that adherence to the use of partographs is still low in many countries. This systematic review aims to review research on the adherence to the use of partographs in childbirth in health services.

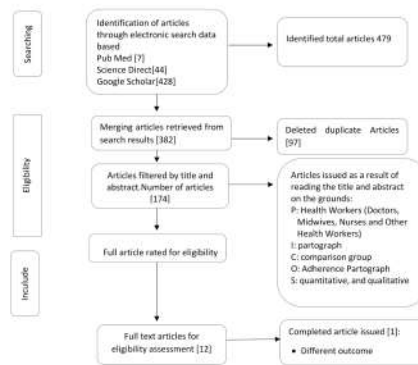
METHOD



Literature is identified through electronic searches on PubMed, Scopus, and Google Scholar



Keywords used included "Partograph" AND "Adherence" AND "Health Care"



RESULT

A total of 12 studies were identified and analyzed. The results showed that adherence to the use of partographs in developing countries ranged from 20% to 80%. Factors associated with low adherence include a lack of training and knowledge of partographs among healthcare workers, lack of resources, and traditional childbirth culture

CONCLUSIONS

Compliance with the use of partographs is still low in health services. Factors influencing compliance include staff shortages, heavy workloads, lack of training, and inadequate monitoring. Recommendations to improve compliance include on-the-job training, routine monitoring, and supportive supervision. The importance of proper partograph use in improving maternal and neonatal outcomes is emphasized.

IMPLICATIONS

The findings of this systematic review can be used to inform policies and programs aimed at improving compliance with the use of partographs in developing countries. Further research is also needed to identify effective interventions to improve compliance in various contexts.

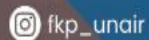
