FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN KEPATUHAN PERAWAT TERHADAP STANDAR OPERASIONAL PROSEDUR PERAWATAN LUKA *POST OP* DI RUANG RAWAT INAP WIJAYA KUSUMA RSUD CIAMIS

Latar Belakang : Kepatuhan perawat terhadap standar operasional prosedur adalah aturan penting yang menjadi acuan dan harus ditaati oleh setiap perawat di berbagai institusi di dunia. Dalam konteks ini, perawat memegang peran strategis dalam upaya pencegahan dan pengendalian infeksi di rumah sakit, perawat juga berperan dalam melakukan observasi dini terhadap tanda-tanda infeksi, mengidentifikasi faktor risiko, melaksanakan tindakan pencegahan berdasarkan Standar Operasional Prosedur (SOP), serta mendokumentasikan setiap tindakan secara tepat. **Tujuan :** Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan kepatuhan perawat terhadap standar operasional prosedur (SOP) perawatan luka *post op* di Ruang Rawat Inap Wijaya Kusuma RSUD Ciamis tahun 2025. **Metode penelitian :** Jenis penelitian yang digunakan adalah metode kuantitatif dengan pendekatan deskriptif korelasional. Sampel penelitian ini berjumlah 22 responden yang diambil menggunakan metode *total sampling*. Analisa data menggunakan uji *Chi Square*. Hasil penelitian, hubungan antara variable independen dengan kepatuhan perawat terhadap standar operasional prosedur perawatan luka *post op* memiliki nilai *Chi Square* 0,000 - 0,002 <0,05. **Kesimpulan :** Terdapat hubungan antara faktor pendidikan, faktor pengalaman kerja, dan faktor motivasi dengan kepatuhan perawat terhadap standar operasional prosedur perawatan luka *post op* di Ruang Rawat Inap RSUD Ciamis. **Saran :** Temuan ini dapat dijadikan masukan untuk perawat terus meningkatkan motivasi dan kesadaran akan pentingnya kepatuhan terhadap SOP perawatan luka *post op*.

FACTORS RELATED TO NURSES' COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR POST-OPERATIVE WOUND CARE IN THE WIJAYA KUSUMA INPATIENT UNIT OF CIAMIS REGIONAL HOSPITAL

Background: Nurses' compliance with standard operating procedures (SOPs) is an important guideline that must be followed by every nurse in healthcare institutions worldwide. In this context, nurses play a strategic role in preventing and controlling infections in hospitals. They are also responsible for early observation of infection signs, identifying risk factors, implementing preventive measures based on SOPs, and documenting every action accurately. **Objective:** This study aimed to analyze the factors associated with nurses' compliance with SOPs for post-operative wound care in the Wijaya Kusuma Inpatient Unit of Ciamis Regional Hospital in 2025. **Methods:** This research used a quantitative approach with a descriptive correlational design. The sample consisted of 22 respondents selected using a total sampling technique. Data were analyzed using the Chi-Square test. **Results:** The results showed that the relationship between independent variables and nurses' compliance with SOPs for post-operative wound care had Chi-Square values ranging from 0.000 to 0.002 (<0.05). **Conclusion:** There is a significant relationship between education, work experience, and motivation with nurses' compliance with SOPs for post-operative wound care in the inpatient unit of Ciamis Regional Hospital. **Suggestion:** These findings can serve as input for nurses to continuously improve their motivation and awareness of the importance of compliance with SOPs in post-operative wound care.
